We are a culturally diverse, inclusive Nursery School and Children’s Centre within the London Borough of Barnet. We pride ourselves on the support we offer all children including those with additional and complex needs.

We would like to share a window into our schools. Our BEYA Nursery Schools are places of possibility; living spaces where children and childhood are honoured, their ideas and abilities valued. A place where children and adults are learning from each other. Where children are seen as individuals and achievements are celebrated.

We value free play and open ended learning as opposed to fixed goals and outcomes. Free play is an essential and beneficial right of all children. In our schools of possibilities, adults observe children to understand rather than assess against measurable targets. We observe their innovation, their creativity, their ideas, their intents and feelings. The insight that we gain enables us to discuss, reflect and plan our environment to support and shape future learning.

Free Entitlement to Early Education

AGE: 3-4 YEARS – ALL children eligible

From the term after their 3rd birthday, **ALL** children are entitled to 15 hours free early education.

AGE: 3-4 YEARS - Working families (WF)

From the term after their 3rd birthday children of working families may be entitled to 30 hours free early education.

AGE: 2 YEARS - Free entitlement (FEE2)

From the term after their 2nd birthday **SOME** children are entitled to 15 hours free early education.

AGE: 2 YEARS – Working families (WF)

From the term after their 2nd birthday children of working families may be entitled to 15 hours free early education.

AGE: 0 – 2 YEARS (Brookhill only) Please visit our website for current fees.

If eligible for 30 hours FREE early education this must be taken over 5 days - 9am -3pm, Monday to Friday

Holiday and extended day provision

We offer all year round provision for children attending our nursery schools. Children from other schools may attend during school holidays. This is available for reception and Year 1 children (4-7 years old). This is based at Brookhill Nursery School.

Lunch sessions: Children attending for lunch will need to bring a packed lunch.

Breakfast and Tea: Charges include food at all three schools.
